- \$2,000 is owed to SEMCU from the low flow grant and \$1,062 is owed to Pegasus from a loan
- Igal Treibatch, Secretary
  - Igal brought up the question why invest any money in them if you're not going to get any credit?
  - The first dry well we are testing took place today and we are working with Provost and Pritchard and Berkeley National Laboratory
  - Started at 1:20pm and was pumping 140 gallons per minute
  - When the dry well was checked at 5:30pm the water never came up
  - The dry well project would like to be turned into a county wide project through the Prop 1 grant

#### ■ Discussion Items

- RWMG Report Al Solis read from minutes of meeting held on November 13<sup>th</sup>
  - Nearly 2 billion available for eligible producers affected by 2017 wildfires
  - The financials include \$38,356.40 and the 2019 budget was submitted
  - The new member dues will be \$3,000 per year
  - The 3<sup>rd</sup> draft of the Prop 1 plan update was distributed, and all requested changes and additions have been made
  - A discussion of the dry well project being added and having them available for everyone
  - The next sub basin GSP advisory committee meeting will be held on December 5<sup>th</sup> at 12pm in Chowchilla
  - The next RWMG meeting will be held on December 10<sup>th</sup> at 1:30pm at the Madera County Government Center

### Grant Reports

- Report from Owen Kubit
  - Owen submitted the written report for the low flow grant
  - Owen will send to Matt an email with the notice to release the retention for the low flow
  - The benefits of the low flow grant include an estimated 110 million gallons will be conserved for the future
  - Out of the \$220,000 granted, we used around \$110,000 for the low flow
  - For the washer grant, 37 apps in August and September came in and a lot of money coming into the community
- Status of Dry Wells and Well Meters
  - Started with testing of the first dry well today at 1:40pm with 140 gallons per minute
