 - The CDFW has released their 2019 Proposition 1 & Proposition 68 Grant Opportunities Proposal **Solicitation Notice**
 - The Groundwater Resources Association is hosting a conference aimed at bringing the gap in knowledge among sky, surface and groundwater – to be held on Jan. 28th and 29th
 - Carl J presented the 2019 budget
 - Jeannie H is going to resign on December 31st and she will be moving into a full-time position with the County to work in their water department
 - The next meeting is on Monday, January 14th,2018 at 1:30pm in Oakhurst

Grant Reports

- Report from Owen Kubit
 - Owen was not present, but emailed Matt there was not much to report
 - Owen said the 2014 low flow grant is finished and we are trying to collect unpaid bills
 - The 2016 grant is going fine with lots of rebates.
 - Owen will need to finish the latest progress report
- Status of Dry Wells and Well Meters
 - Igal mentioned testing was still happening with the wells and they are taking in a consistent 600 gallons of water per minute
 - Testing is simulating a rain storm and the wells are able to take the water
 - 7 total residential wells were drilled this past weekend
 - 4 more are scheduled for next week as it got too wet with the rain
 - Igal said he will have to negotiate a better price with the driller
