  - November's Flood-MAR Program's lunchtime webinar recording available
  - California Water Commission has released its 2025 Strategic Plan released
  - DWR provisional Water Year 2023 Statewide Land Use Data released
  - CNRA will brief on implementing the Climate Bond
  - CAL FIRE will host a Zoom webinar on California Community Wildfire Protection Plans
  - January 2025 Financial Report Balance: \$23,641.60
  - Officer Elections kept same Chairperson and Vice-Chair
  - Chowchilla Nitrate Control Program / Chowchilla Management Zone CMZ continues to send out mailers and perform water tests, providing bottled water to those whose domestic wells have tested high in Nitrates (over 10 mg/L). Their 2025 budget was approved unanimously by their committee, and they've sent out their assessment billing invoices to their participants. Most of their efforts right now are in working with their tech consultants in collecting and preparing information for the annual Management Zone Implementation Plan (MZIP) that will be submitted to the State Water Board in March.
    - IGAL mentioned he might write an SEMCU speaks article in the Ranchos about this.]
    - Al said he could get a phone number at the Chowchilla Management Zone for people to call who were interested in getting the free bottled water
    - Igal mentioned a non-profit (Self-Help) that previously also helped with water needs
  - Proposition 1 IRWM Implementation Funding Cities of Madera & Chowchilla
  - SGMA Implementation Grant
  - Drought Working Group Snow drought
    - Next meeting will be on 2/21 w/ a speaker from NOAA
    - Meeting in May/June will include a presentation on clean drinking water and well replacement; possibly with a USDA Drought Rescue Resource presentation
  - Hidden Lakes Water Storage Tanks and Fill Line Project Ending soon
  - New Members None
  - DWR IRWM Branch Representative will attend April 28<sup>th</sup> meeting re: Prop 4 Funding
    - Igal mentioned that he would like to attend that meeting
  - Al needs to coordinate to schedule a Supervisors lunch that would include you
  - Fresno Land is doing an article on the Williamson Act on the millions of dollars being spent
- o Grants Meetings Research Results from Paul Negrete, SEMCU Board Member
  - Grants Found under USDA No applications yet but is going to pull one & send to Igal
  - Igal mentioned again that it might fit seniors & SEMCU
