  - No grants found as of today Getting form #:424 to fill out
  - Paul has noticed that, in the searches, he needs to note we can do matching funds to see more grants, even if SEMCU doesn't qualify

## ■ New Business Discussion Items

- Treasurer Duties Transfer from Verlaine Elinburg, Treasurer
  - Verlaine is moving out-of-state; will come to Madera one-week-a-month
  - Verlaine is NOT selling her home (renting it out), so it can still be used as SEMCU's local address and the person handling future Treasurer duties can check the mail
  - Verlaine suggested handing the duties of SEMCU Treasurer to the Ranchos Maderas Controller there in the town; instead, asked Anthony if he wants the duties
  - Anthony doesn't have time at the beginning of the year; but can later this year
  - Transfer of Verlaine's personal phone # (by T-Mobile) back to her personal phone
  - SEMCU will mention the Crab Feed flyer for March 7<sup>th</sup> on it's own back page
  - Verlaine suggested buying a space for SEMCU's banner at the March 7 Crab Feed
  - Discussed if anyone wants to purchase 3/7 crab feed tickets (table of 10 = \$700)
  - For another \$100, SEMCU can put up their banner at the event
  - Proposal to buy a table for 10 + the sign (for \$100): Igal motioned to pass
  - 2<sup>nd</sup>: Anthony
  - Vote: all in favor
- Dry Well Grant Initial grant built 146 dry wells & ended, with no further funds available;
   RWMG did not agree to fund a second grant
- SEMCU Speaks for Ranchos Independent
